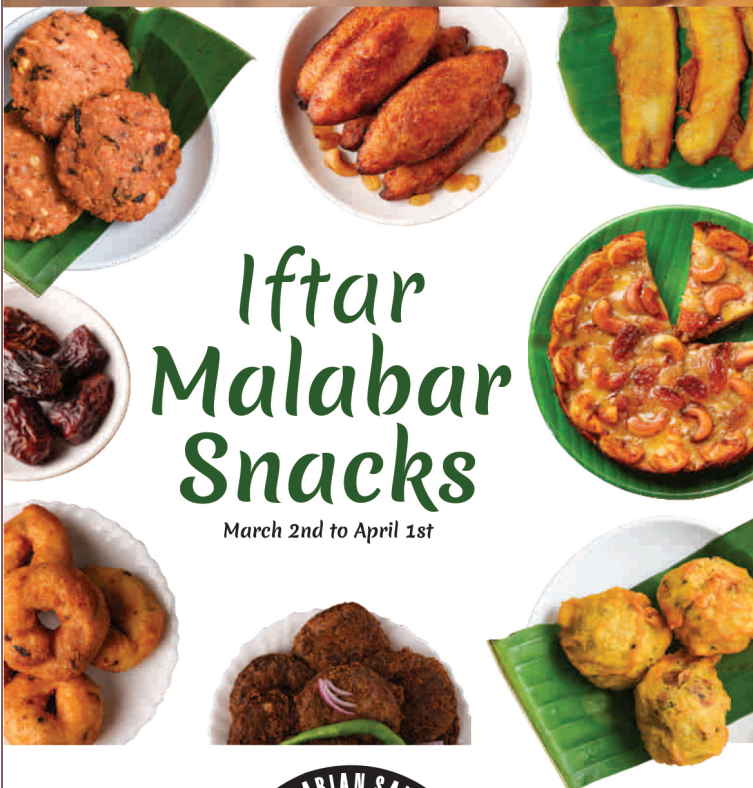

## Southern Railway Announces Changes in Suburban Train Services on March 9

The Southern Railway Chennai Division has announced changes in suburban train services on March 9, 2025 (Sunday) due to the commissioning of the 4th railway line between Chennai Beach and Chennai Egmore. A line block/signal block will be in effect from 05:10 hrs to 16:10 hrs (11 hours), leading to train cancellations and special arrangements.

Service Changes:  
-Chennai Beach - Tambaram - Chennai Beach EMU trains will be fully cancelled from 05:10 hrs to 16:10 hrs. Instead, Passenger Specials will run between Tambaram and Kodambakkam every 30 minutes.  
-Chennai Beach - Chengalpattu/ Kanchipuram / Tirumalpur/Arakkonam - Chennai Beach EMU trains will be partially cancelled between Chennai Beach and Tambaram during the same period.

## POLYCYSTIC OVARY SYNDROME - ADVT



PCOS is an endocrine system disorder which affects most of the women during their reproductive age. Nowadays 8-20% of the women are affected from this and also 70% of the fertility issues are due to PCOS.

CAUSES  
While the precise cause for PCOS remains unclear and unknown, specific research has indicated few causes like potential genetic connection (that certain genes might be linked to PCOS), excess insulin, low grade inflammation. PCOS is characterized by two or more of the following: Hyperandrogenism, Polycystic ovaries, Chronic anovulation (cycle length more than 35 days), acanthosis nigricans (darkening of skin), Thinning of hair and skin tags.

Androgen excess accelerates the initial activation of primordial follicles for growth while triggering premature luteinization, leading to impaired dominant follicle selection. These processes contribute to characteristic histopathological and gross anatomical changes seen in PCOS. Likewise, all the above-mentioned causes play a major role in this condition.

SYMPTOMS:  
Individuals with PCOS may also encounter Irregular menstrual cycle like abnormal, irregular, or scanty (oligomenorrhea), absent menses (amenorrhea), elevated androgen concentrations, unwanted hair growth, skin breakouts (acne), and Obesity.

Women with PCOS have increased risk of developing Endometrial cancer, infertility, Type 2 diabetes mellitus (DM) and also might develop IGT, low-grade inflammation Pre-eclampsia, Obesity, NAFLD and NASH, Depression.

## Exciting makeover of Chetpet Eco Park is on the cards!!

The CMDA or Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority has proposed renovation works at the Eco Park in Chetpet for around Rs 10 cr. This is one of the go-to recreation spots in Chennai for many.

Information gathered is that CMDA would create water sports facilities, musical fountains, bird-view decks plus renovated fishing spots, rock climbing space, aquarium, an amphitheatre etc. The toilets and walkways here would also be upgraded by the CMDA.

Major objectives of CMDA: It must be taken into account that the objectives of CMDA would be to refurbish urban green spaces in Chennai to mitigate pollution effects. In addition, urban heat island effect would be lowered. It is known that urban heat island is a phenomenon associated with heat trapped in built-up areas. The document from CMDA has mentioned that the urban heat island in towns and cities has been due to the effect of human activities.

It must be recalled that in 2017 the Fisheries department of TN rejuvenated Chetpet Lake and developed an eco-park on 16 acres of land. It is noteworthy that Chetpet has been in a neglected state due to sewage pollution and overgrown vegetation etc. The Chetpet eco-park is also a boating destination within the Chennai limits.

Every month, this eco-park attracts about 20000 visitors and around 500 walkers use the walkways around the lake for their morning walks.

**Tamil Nadu Govt Releases Guidelines for  
Issuing Patta on Govt-Owned Lands**

The Tamil Nadu government has released detailed guidelines for issuing patta (land ownership documents) to residents of government-owned lands across the state. However, patta will not be issued for residents on water bodies, pasture lands, temple lands, or lands where ownership is unclear. Key guidelines include: Residents in the Chennai metropolitan area must have lived on the land for more than 10 years to be eligible. Residents in other areas must have lived on the land for more than 5 years to qualify. Families with an annual income of less than ₹3 lakh will receive patta free of cost. The government aims to issue patta to approximately 86,000 people across the state within the next six months as part of this initiative.
